

Cosplay and Props at King Con

PROPS AND WEAPONS

- Real, replica and imitation firearms are not allowed please refer to <u>Victoria Police</u> for details on imitation firearms
- Toy or cosplay firearms/weapons must be inoperable (must not be able to launch projectiles) and easily distinguished as a toy/prop
- Metal weapons and/or any sharp items are not allowed
- Allowed weapons must be blunt and soft to avoid accidental injury
- Weapons are not to be pointed, swung or brandished at anyone
 (Some exemptions may apply to presenters, with prior arrangement with staff)
- You must be aware of your surroundings when handling your cosplay weapons

COSTUMES

- This is a family event in a public space, please be mindful of this when choosing your costume. Staff may ask you to remove / cover up unsuitable attire
- Costumes may not have sharp edges or spikes
- Overly bulky costumes may prevent free movement through the space, please use your best judgement and be mindful of others

GENERAL

- King Con and library staff have final say on costumes and props
- If you bring an item that we deem unsuitable, please be ready to either return it to your vehicle or surrender it to staff. Your item can be collected from staff as you leave
